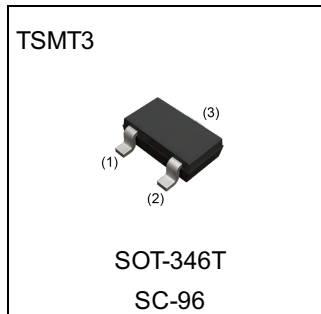

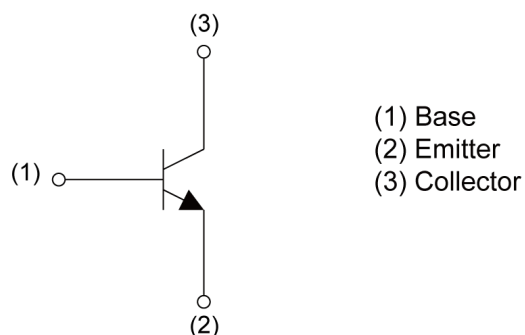

Fig.1 Ground Emitter Propagation Characteristics

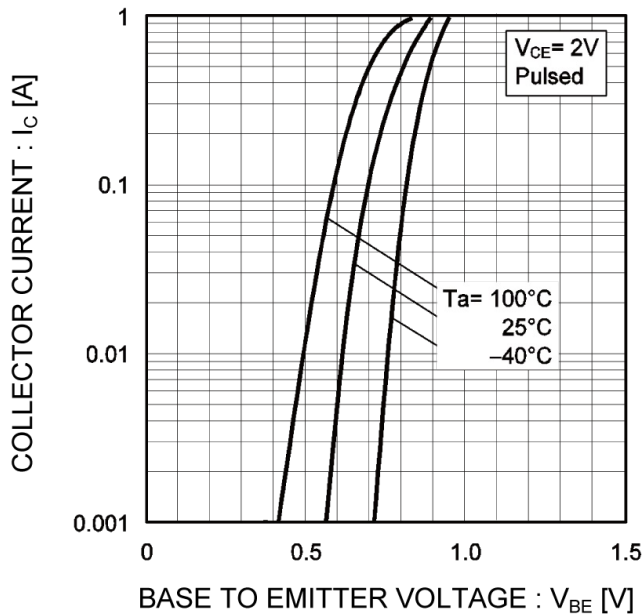


Fig.2 Typical Output Characteristics

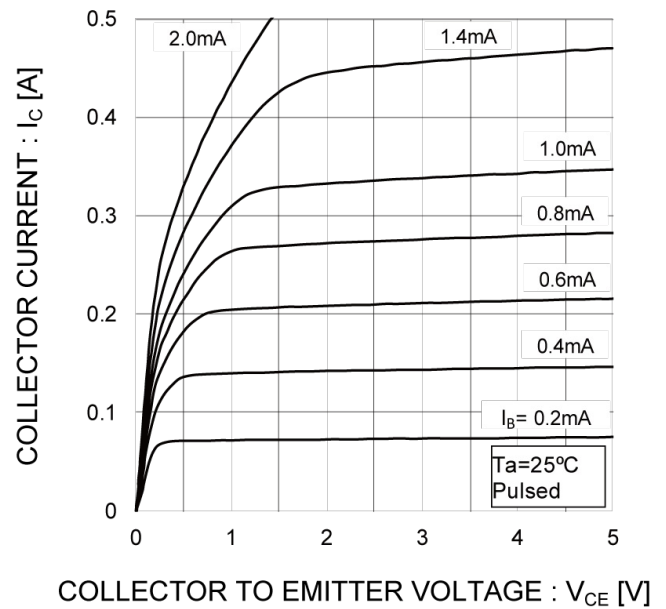


Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (I)

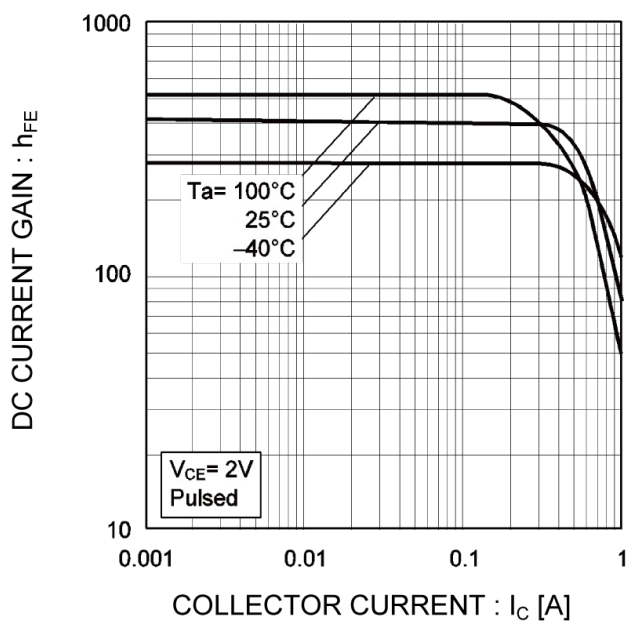
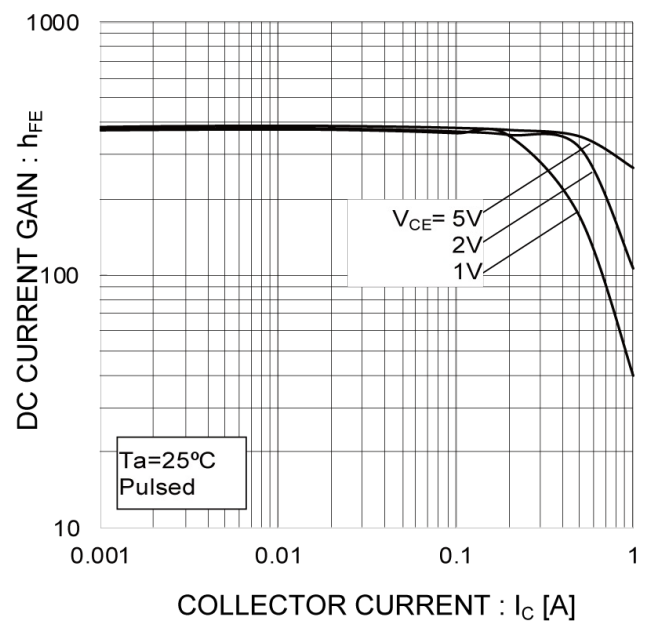


Fig.4 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current (II)

Voltage vs. Collector Current (I)

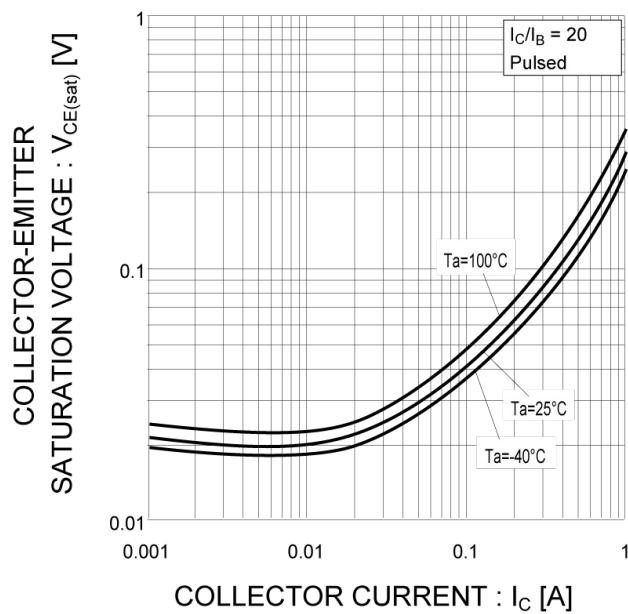


Fig.6 Collector-Emitter Saturation
Voltage vs. Collector Current (II)

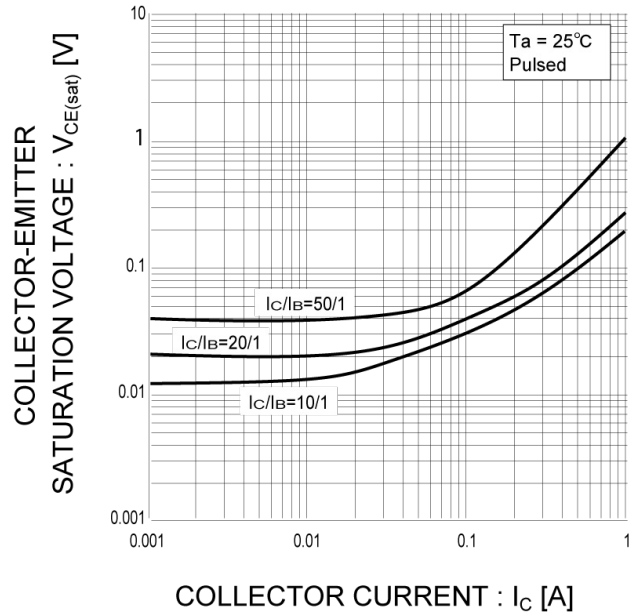


Fig.7 Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
vs. Collector Current

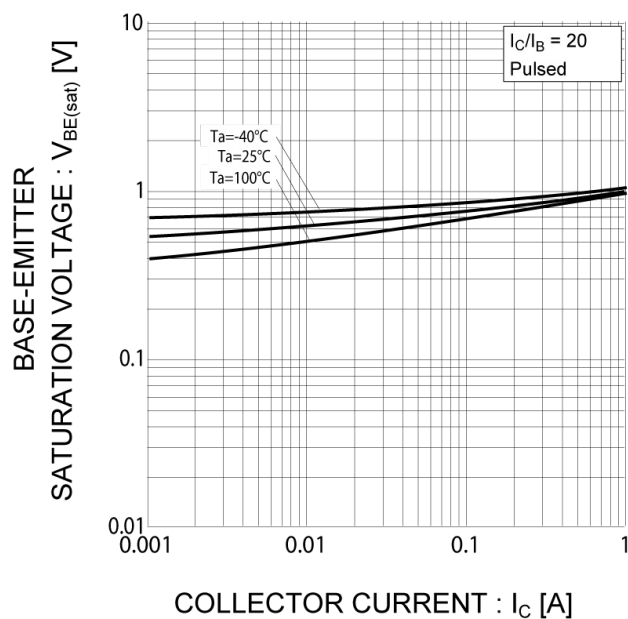
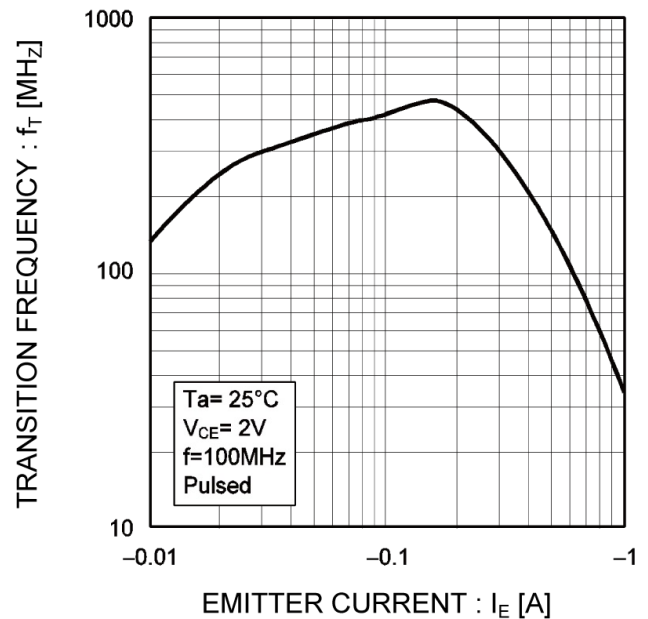


Fig.8 Gain Bandwidth Product vs.

Collector-Base Voltage

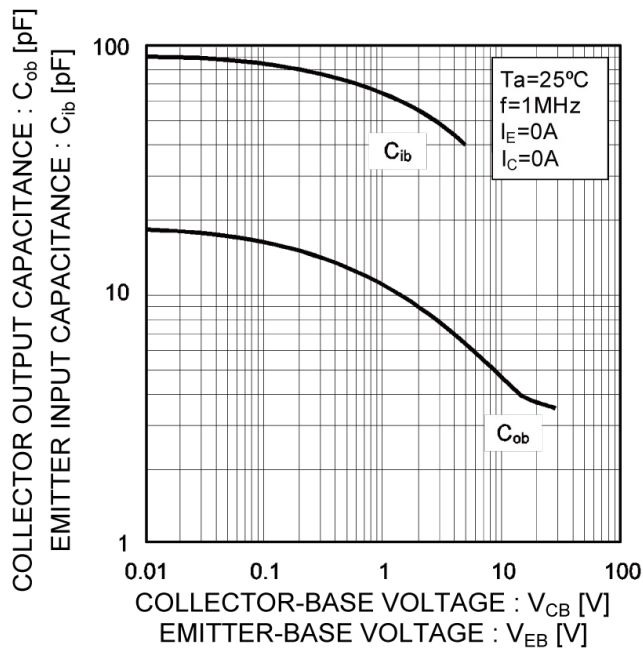
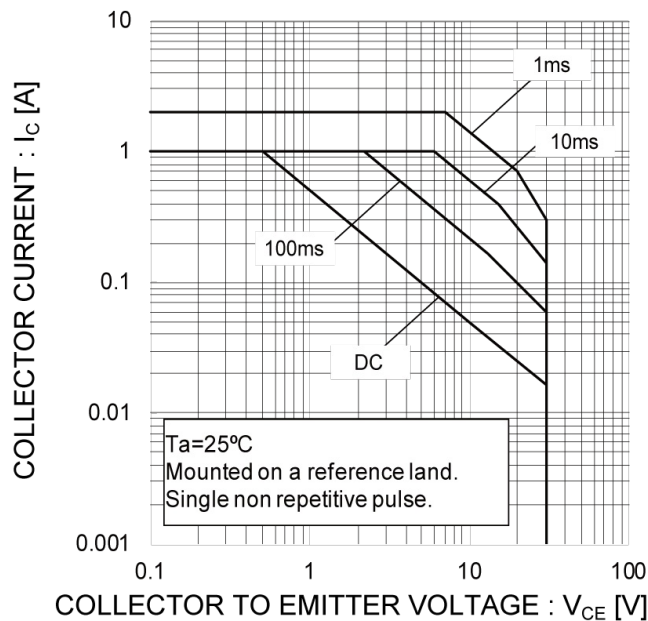
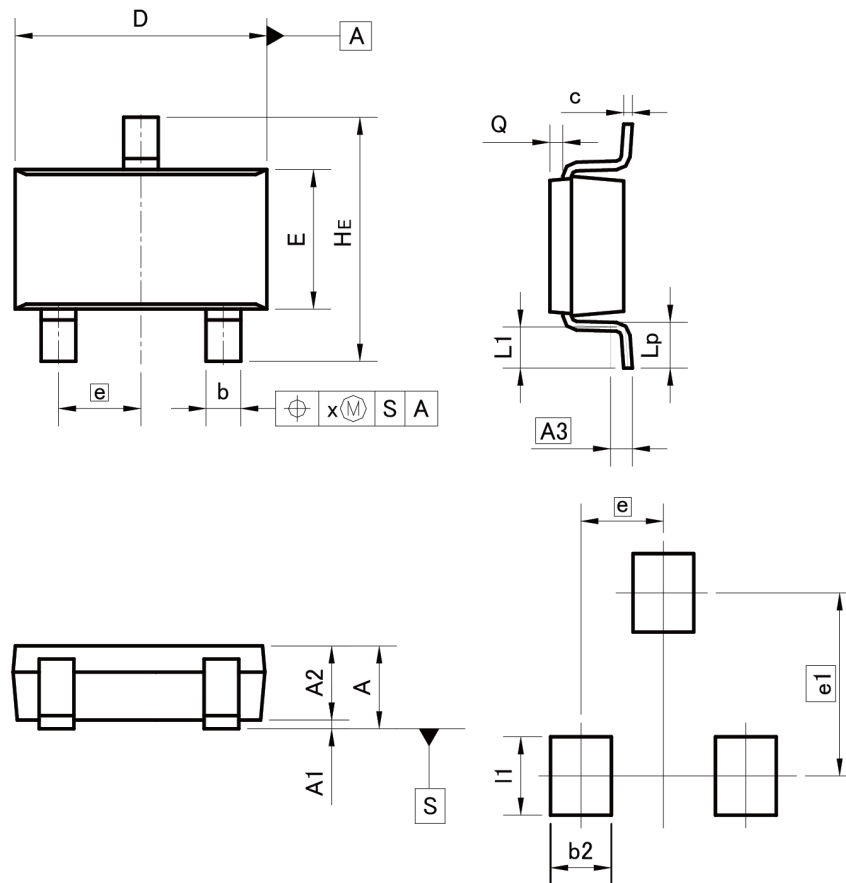


Fig.10 Safe Operating Area (I)
